Discussion Questions:

- 1) What are the main migrant/refugee populations in your neighbourhood/city/town? Are there any conflicts or issues with integration that you are aware of facing this community? What other issues might they be facing?**
- 2) Are there existing social agencies or grassroots organizations in your community that work on migrant support issues? What would it look like to participate with these groups, either by joining directly or participating in a coalition? What issues might emerge?**
- 3) Are there other issues that people are already organizing around (housing, healthcare, anti-police) that you could better incorporate migrant issues into? What would this look like in practice, and what kinds of organizing would be required in order to make this meaningful, and just not a rhetorical shift?**
- 4) What is the role of the established political process in terms of migrant support work? Are they worth trying to pressure directly on a local level? What do people think about the sanctuary cities model, and how should anarchists engage with it?**
- 5) What is the relationship between migrant/refugee support work and Indigenous sovereignty issues?**
