How has opposition to Trump normalized or even increased support for the Democratic Party, or other aspects of the American state (ie the judiciary, state regulators, etc). What are some of the inherent dangers associated with this dynamic, and how can anarchists avoid falling into these traps?

How can the types of coalition-building efforts that goes into preparing for large counter-summits like J20 be maintained and expanded once these events are over? Can these types of summits be used to strengthen local organizing projects? If so, how?

What would a successful movement to stop Trump look like? What would this even look like in practice?
